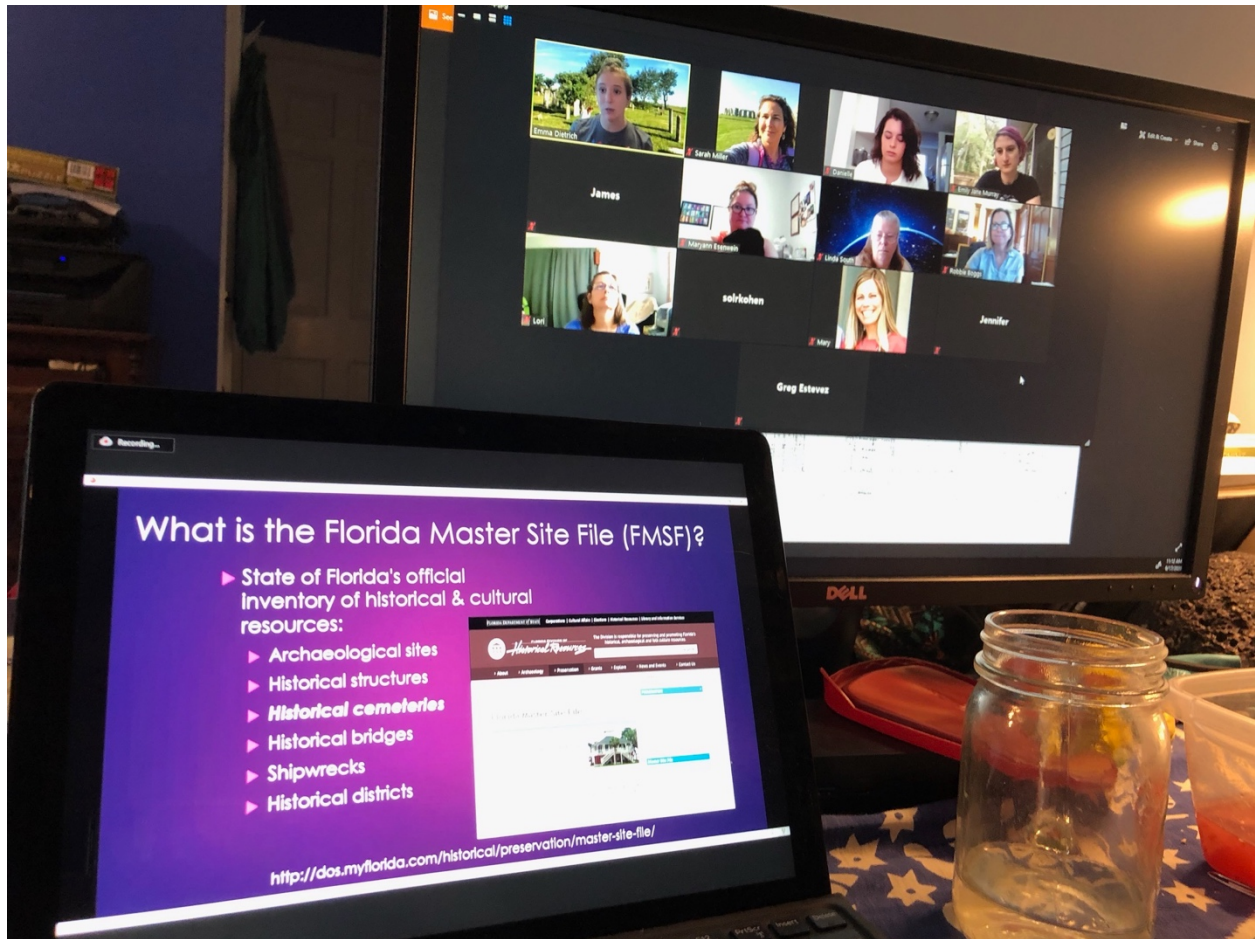


This year, the Northeast Region’s Summer Archaeology Book Club went virtual as attendees discussed books via Zoom.
